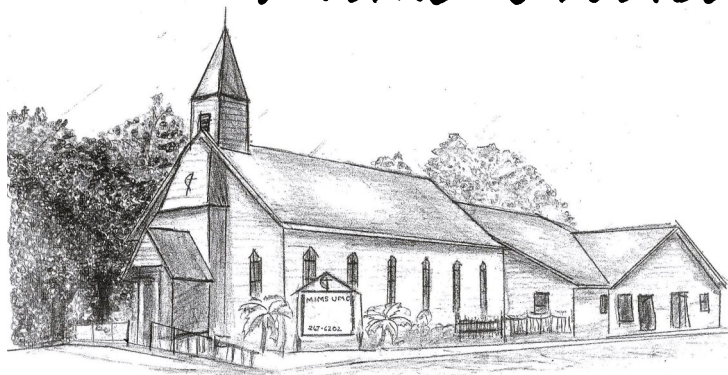

Holy Week and Easter Worship

During Holy Week, we will hold one mid-week service on **Maundy Thursday**, April 18, at 6:30 p.m. On **Good Friday**, April 19, at 2:00 p.m., we are invited to participate in a community service at the historic LaGrange Church (1575 Old Dixie Hwy). Pastors (including Pastor John) from the historic churches in Titusville will share devotions on The Seven Last Words from the Cross. On **Easter Sunday**, we will hold two services: the early “Sunrise” service, will be at Marina Park at 7:00 a.m. (bring lawn chairs, and jackets or blankets as needed.), and a 10:00 a.m. worship service in the Sanctuary.
